Ad Hoc

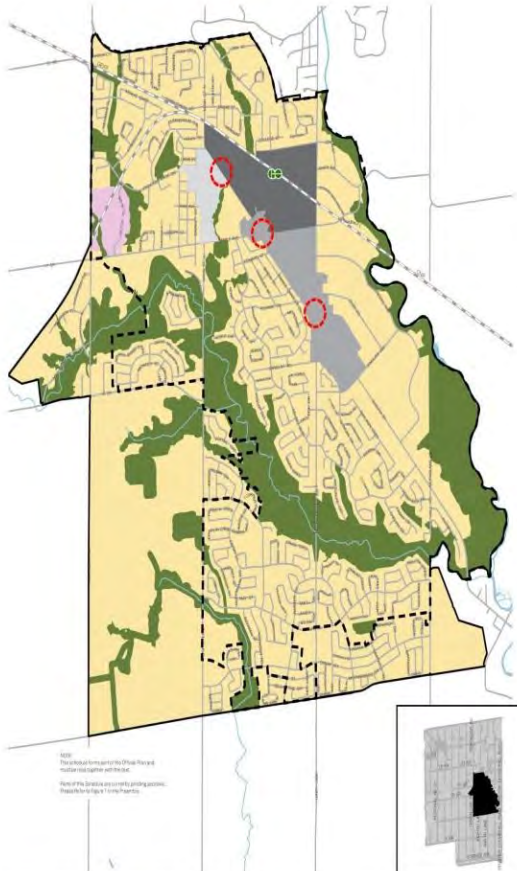
- Monday to Sunday, 7:00am – 11:00pm
- Trips outside of the regular ActiVan operating hours or that can not be accommodated on ActiVan during peak hours.
- Fare: \$3.00/\$4.00



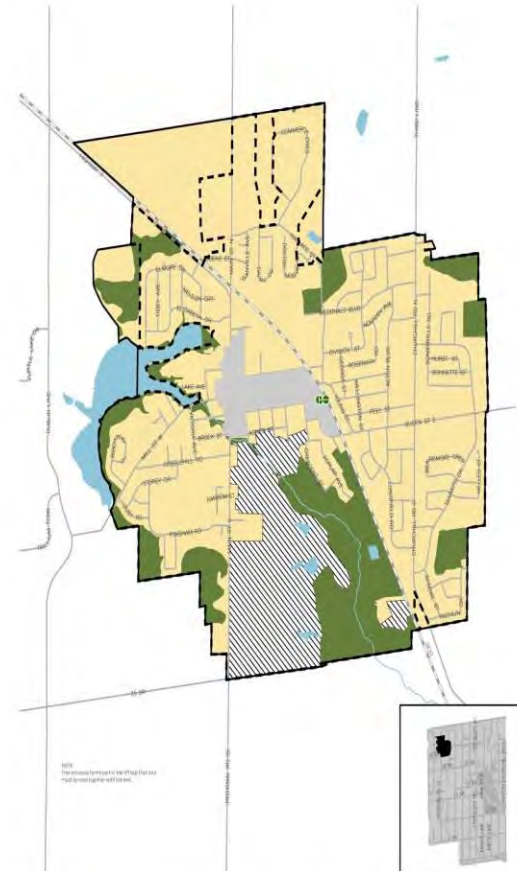
Taxi Scrip / Youth Taxi Scrip

- Provides subsidized taxi rides to users outside of regular operating hours, or at the convenience of the user.
- Registered ActiVan users or youth
- 60/40 cost shared

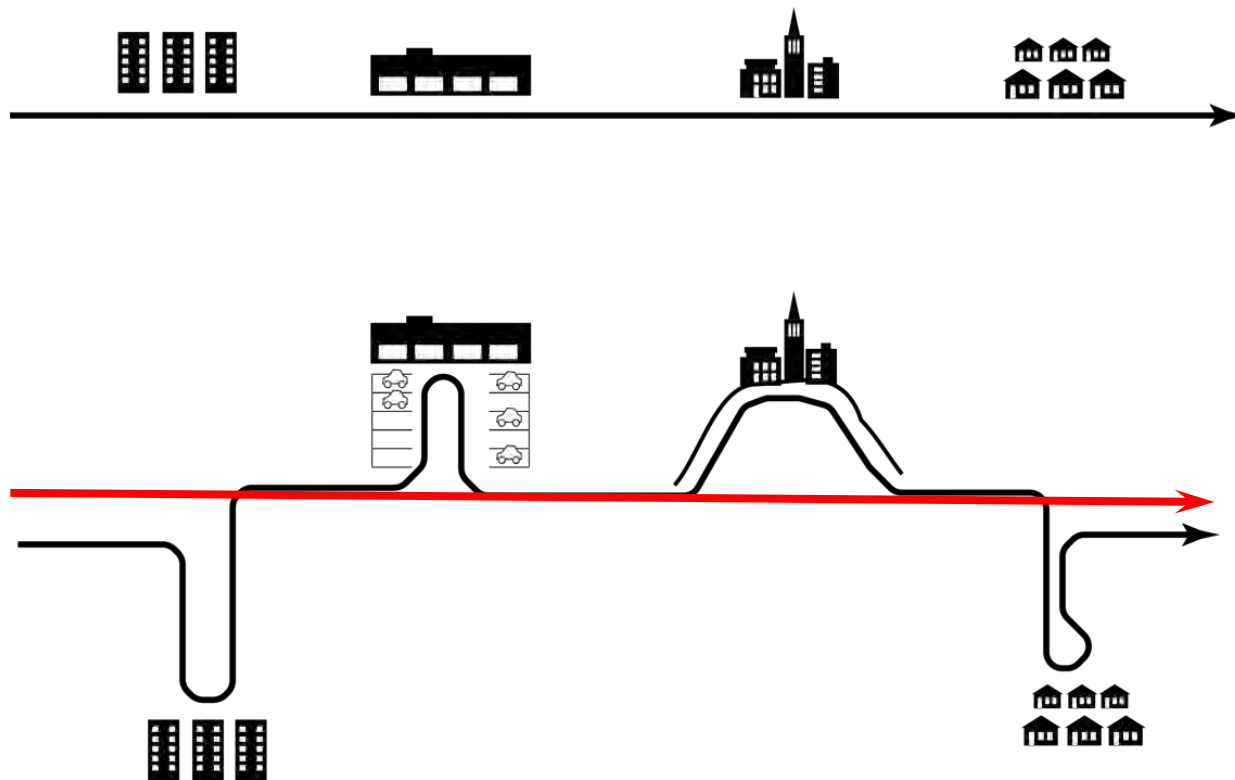

- Planning for two-way, all-day GO rail service

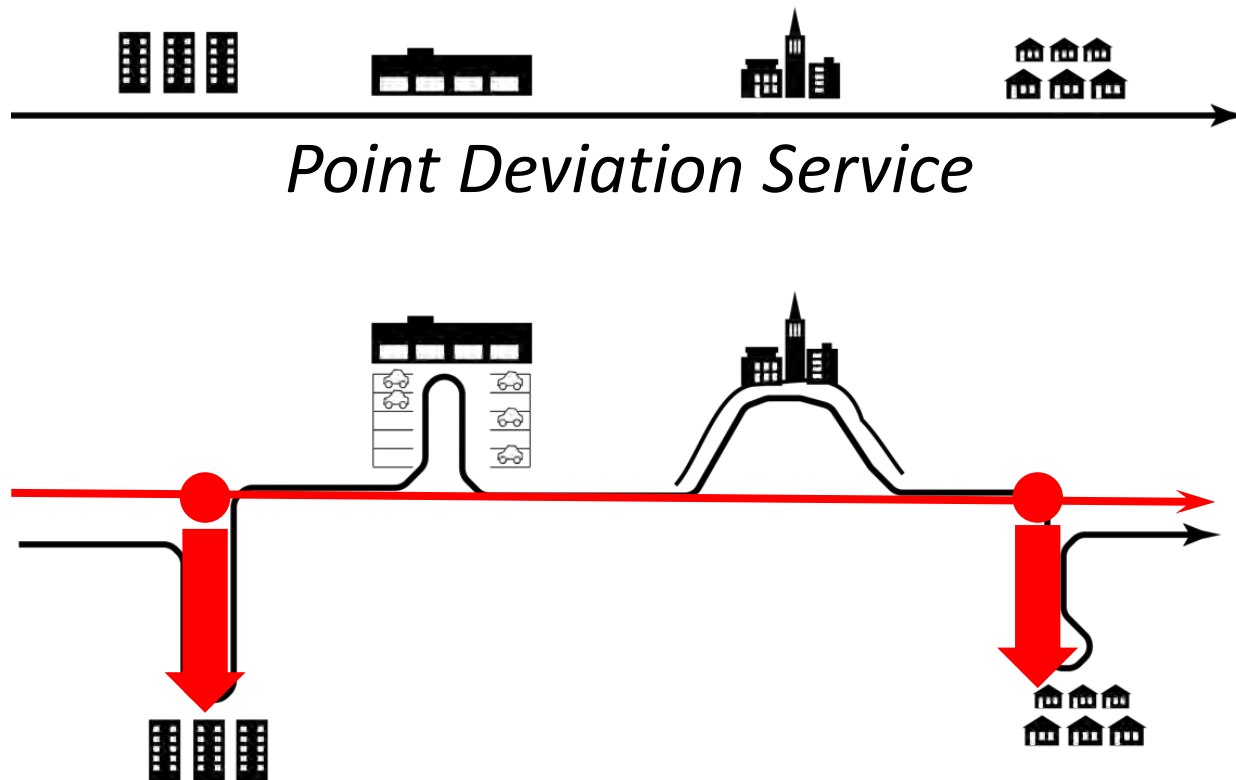

Fixed route and special transportation are the only options

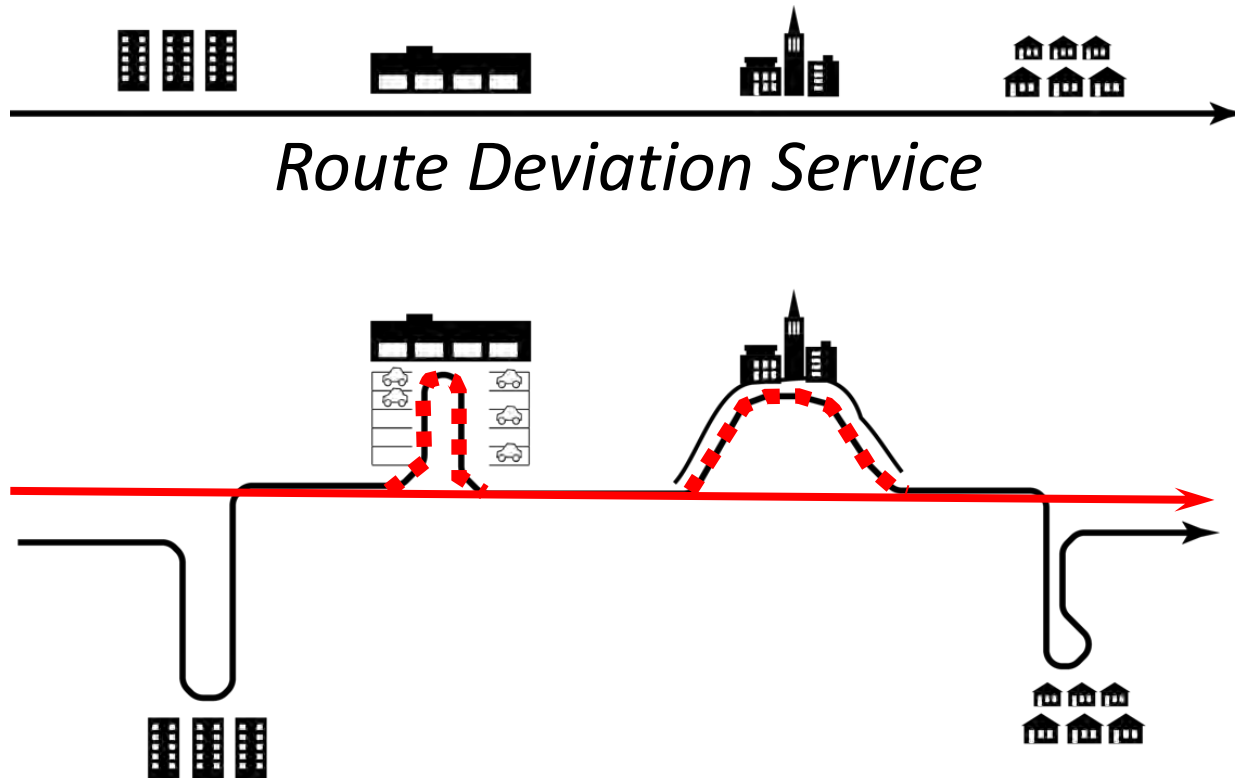

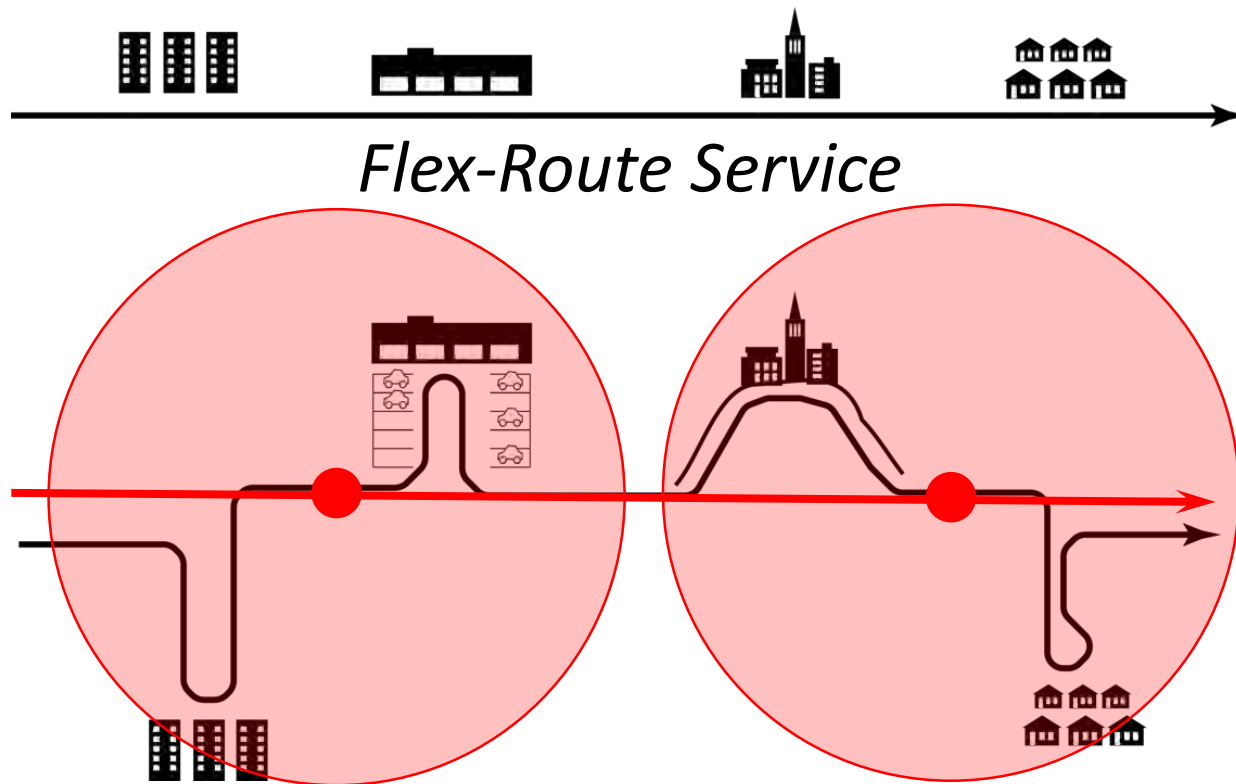
