

BY-LAW NO. 2017-0042

A By-law to repeal Interim Control By-law 2016-0009, as amended, which controlled the erection of, and additions resulting in, any large scale single-detached dwellings within defined areas of the Town of Halton Hills, during completion of the Mature Neighbourhoods Character Study.

WHEREAS on February 29, 2016, Council for the Town of Halton Hills enacted Interim Control By-law No. 2016-0009 to control the erection of, and additions resulting in, any large scale single-detached dwellings within defined areas of the Town of Halton Hills for a period of one year, to manage change in the Town's mature neighbourhoods during completion of the Mature Neighbourhoods Character Study.

AND WHEREAS on February 21, 2017, Council for the Town of Halton Hills enacted Bylaw No. 2017-0009 to extend the period of time during which Interim Control By-law 2016-0009 was in effect, by one additional year, to February 28, 2018.

AND WHEREAS on May 29, 2017, through Report No. P&I-2017-0056, Council for the Town of Halton Hills enacted By-laws Nos. 2017-0032 and 2017-0033, which respectively contained Official Plan Amendment No. 22 and Zoning By-law Amendment No. 2017-0033, which implement the final recommendations of the Mature Neighbourhoods Character Study.

AND WHEREAS on June 29, 2017, the 30-day appeal period for By-laws Nos. 2017-0032 and 2017-0033 expired, thereby bringing Official Plan Amendment No. 22 and Zoning By-law Amendment No. 2017-0033 into force and effect, and thereby completing the Mature Neighbourhoods Character Study in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Interim Control By-law 2016-0009, as amended, is hereby repealed.
