**AND WHEREAS** The cause of NMOSD is still a mystery and there are a few approved treatments for the majority of patients with NMOSD; but no treatments for the remainder of patients;

**AND WHEREAS** When mistaken for other diseases, treatments can exacerbate NMOSD symptoms;

**AND WHEREAS** Increasing awareness about NMOSD has caused diagnoses to rise, as doctors have become more likely to recognize the varying manifestations of the disease;

**AND WHEREAS** The NMOSD community is dedicated to increasing awareness and understanding of this disease in order to promote research, improved patient care, and outcomes, and ultimately find a cure.
