Mold-Masters SportsPlex 221 Guelph Street (Hwy 7), Georgetown

Our largest facility offers 4 ice pads, 2 community halls, 2 meeting rooms and parking for hundreds of cars including charging stations for electric vehicles. Skateboarders will want to head to the skatepark, located at the southern side of the property facing Guelph St.

This community facility was expanded and modernized in 2013 to include the latest in environmentally sustainable building technology. Built to LEED Silver standards, sustainability was not only a priority during construction but also in everyday operation and maintenance. This is a comfortable, modern and inviting place for tournaments, recreational skating and shinny as well as summer events such as trade shows, lacrosse and floor hockey.



Gellert Community Centre 10241 Eighth Line, Georgetown

Surrounded by walking trails, tennis courts, sports fields, children's playground and a splash pad, Gellert Community Centre is a hub of activity all year round. For swimmers, this location is the place to be, featuring Halton Hills' largest pool. Learn to swim in one of our highly qualified instructional programs, or enjoy a recreational family or lane swim. Young swimmers enjoy a special shallow pool with steps and a duck slide. The more adventurous can try the 2-story water slide or tarzan rope. Relax after your swim in the hot tub or sauna.

Gellert is also home to many recreational programs, from summer camps to year-round fitness classes. The bright and sunny Kinsman Hall and Wittich Atrium offer flexible rental space for private functions, fitness classes and more.



Acton Arena & Community Centre 415 Queen Street East (Hwy 7), Acton

This expanded recreation complex meets the growing needs of the Halton Hills community. This modern centre offers 2 full size ice pads, a leisure pad great for children and skating parties, 2 community halls and meeting rooms. The facility is also the home of Hillsview Active Living Centre Acton, offering activities and services to older adults in Halton Hills.

The fun doesn't stop indoors. The Acton Arena & Community Centre is home to the Three Musketeers Park, including a skatepark and multi-purpose sport court. Those seeking outdoor adventure can enjoy three soccer fields, scenic walking trails and a children's playground.
