Subject: **Decision to give written approval of by-laws passed at the January 20, 2025 meeting of Council**

Pursuant to the powers extended to the Head of Council under Sections 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, I, Ann Lawlor, Mayor for the Town of Halton Hills, hereby give written approval of the following by-laws passed at the Town of Halton Hills Council meeting held on January 20, 2025:

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0001 - A By-law to designate the Beaumont Duplex, located at 526 Main Street, Glen Williams, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0002 - A By-law to designate Hawkins House, located at 7 Prince Street, Glen Williams, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0003 - A By-law to designate the Beamish-Appelbe House, located at 5 King Street, Georgetown, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0004 - A By-law to designate the McColl House, located at 4 Queen Street, Georgetown, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0005 - A By-law to designate the Ramsden House, located at 8 Queen Street, Georgetown, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0006 - A By-law to regulate and prohibit the sale and discharge of consumer fireworks and to provide for the issuance of permits for the discharge of display fireworks and to repeal By-law No. 2023-0032.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0007 - A By-law to adopt the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on the 20th day of January, 2025 and to authorize its execution.
